Qualifications

Candidates must be financial members of the Fire Brigade Employees' Union of NSW and must be nominated in writing by at least two (2) financial members of the Fire Brigade Employees' Union of NSW (other than the candidate).

A candidate may not contest more than one Officer position. Where a member is nominated for more than one Officer position the Returning Officer will invite the member to withdraw their multiple nominations so as to limit their nominations to one position. If the member fails to do so before the time stipulated, i.e. 12noon Friday 24 September 2021, all nominations for that member shall be deemed to be withdrawn.

Lodgement of nominations

Completed Nominations must be received by the Returning Officer, NSW Electoral Commission by no later than **5pm, Friday 17 September 2021**. Any anomaly in the Nomination Form must be rectified before this time.

A candidate may withdraw his/her nomination in writing so as to be received by the Returning Officer by 12noon, Friday 24 September 2021. A nomination cannot be withdrawn after this time.

Note: The NSW Electoral Commission's office is currently closed to the public due to COVID-19 related public health requirements and NSWEC staff may be working from home. Voting

Should the election be contested, a draw to determine the order of candidates' names on the ballot paper will be conducted at 2pm, Friday 24 September 2021 at the NSW Electoral Commission. Candidates or their representatives are invited to witness the draw.

All members of the Union who are financial members at the time when the roll of voters for the election closes, i.e. Friday 20 August 2021, shall be entitled to vote in the election for all positions.

Voting material will be posted on Friday 1 October 2021. The poll will close at 5pm, Thursday 28 October 2021 and the count will be conducted at 9am, Friday 29 October 2021. The method of voting to be observed is Optional Preferential.
