Part F. Qualifications to hold office and/or nominate

Candidates must be financial members of the Fire Brigade Employees' Union of NSW and must be nominated in writing by at least two (2) financial members (other than the candidate) of the Fire Brigade Employees' Union of NSW. A candidate may not be nominated for more than one (1) Officer Position.

A candidate may not contest more than one Officer position. Where a member is nominated for more than one Officer position the Returning Officer will invite the member to withdraw their multiple nominations so as to limit their nominations to one position. If the member fails to do so before the time stipulated i.e. 12noon, Friday 24 September 2021, all nominations for that member shall be deemed to be withdrawn.
